This Addendum is issued to provide additional information and clarification to the original Invitation to Bid and shall prevail to the extent of any conflict with the original Invitation to Bid.

Bidders shall acknowledge receipt of this Addendum by inserting its number and date on the Bid Form entitled: **“Addenda Acknowledgement Form” (ACK-1)**, which shall be completed, signed and included with submittal.

- A. The bid opening date has been extended to April 16, 2019, no later than 2:00 PM
- B. Technical Specification Page, TEC-2 of 2 shall be **removed. A revised Technical Specifications Page (Revised TEC-2 of 2) has been attached herein.**
- C. Bid Proposal Form, Page BFM-1 shall be **removed. A Revised Bid Proposal Form (Revised BFM-1) has been attached herein.**
- D. **The following are responses to questions received prior to Thursday, April 4, 2019 as per General Terms and Conditions, Item 12 “Interpretations” :**

Q-1: Labor rate based upon 100 hours. Nothing defines the allotted time to complete a given task. A \$100/hour rate at 10 hours totals \$1000, and a \$75/ hour rate for 15 hours totals \$1125. Clarify the comparatives

A-1: **Please note that the quantity of hours requested on the bid page is an estimate. It is the intent of this solicitation to secure firm fixed prices for track rebuilding and repair. As Per page TEC-1 of 2, Number 3 “Performance”, A. “A written quotation shall be given detailing the scope of work including parts and labor in accordance with the contract pricing prior to beginning a job.”**

Q-2: A similar scenario presents itself with the parts pricing. Different manufacturers have different list prices, therefore the net discount will vary even with different discounts. To my knowledge aftermarket suppliers do not utilize a list price, at least not a published one. 30% off Manufacturer A undercarriage compared to 20% off Manufacturer B undercarriage, the discount is higher as a percentage in Manufacturer A. If manufacturer A costs \$5000 less discount the net is \$3500. If manufacturer B costs \$4000 with discount the net is \$3200. The lower discount nets the better net price. Clarify the comparatives

A-2: **Additional information has been added to a revised TEC-2 of 2 attached herein to clarify the definition of the Price List required. Additionally, a revised Bid Form (attached herein) has been provided to allow multiple manufacturers and discount prices to be submitted with the bid.**

3. RESPONSE TIME

- A. Response time to be within two (2) days of request for on-site repairs and for equipment to be picked up at AUTHORITY location to be transported for repair at awarded bidders shop.
- B. Repair turnaround time shall not exceed five (5) business days after starting work, or as directed by an authorized AUTHORITY employee.

4. EQUIPMENT

- A. All Bidders shall provide a complete list and description of all equipment available to provide required activities. All equipment needed to perform the required work shall be furnished by the Bidder at no additional cost to the AUTHORITY.
- All hardware MUST be grade 8 or better
 - All sealed and lubricated track assembly must be vacuum tested, oil-filled, not to have any dry joints, and include a warranty.

6. MANUFACTURERER SUGGESTED RETAIL PRICE (MSRP)

- A. The MSRP list is defined as a list(s) that is common to, and accepted by, the industry in general. The submitted list(s) must be published, properly identified and dated as to issuance and effectiveness. For the purpose of this solicitation and bid uniformity, the acronym MSRP is intended to represent any means the manufacturers conveys to the consumer or public retail pricing. In some cases, manufacturer use the following terms interchangeably: MSRP (Manufacturer Suggested Retail Price), MRP (Manufacturer Retail Price) or RP (Retail Price). Submission based on price lists that reflects government, resale, whole sale, jobber, internet and any other non-retail pricing from the manufacturer **will not be considered**. The list submitted by the BIDDER(s) may be confirmed through the manufacturer.
- B. If the successful BIDDER issues an updated MSRP list or replacements to the Manufacturers Suggested Retail Price (MSRP) list(s), after the initial contract period, the successful BIDDER shall submit such replacement to Purchasing Services at 7501 North Jog Road, West Palm Beach, FL 33412, to the attention of the Purchasing agent identified in the bid. These replacements are to be received no less than twenty-one (21) calendar days prior to the effective date of such changes. The successful BIDDER must also deliver copies of the replacement Manufacturers Suggested Retail Price (MSRP) list(s), if no electronic versions are available to all departments that have Purchase Orders open with the company
